- Setup and make adjustments of machines/filling lines.
- Assist line setter in setting up lines during product changes
- Identify and remedy machine faults and failures.
- Running of one or more lines and team of people including Herrco and Agency staff.
- Interpret specifications and job orders to workers, and assigns duties.
- Achieve optimum line throughput and line efficiencies.
- Support supervisors and production manager in the daily running of production
- Ensure assembly of finished goods is to the specification and quality standards
- Perform on-line quality control checks
- Complete all packing lists and paperwork in full within the time frame required.
- Maintain good housekeeping at all times within your area/ everything is in its place.
- Interprets company policies to staff members and enforce and maintain safety and quality regulations.
- Communicate daily and directly to your Supervisor in order to understand operational targets.
